WHAT IS WORLD AIDS DAY?

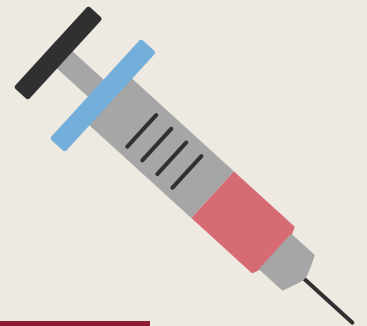
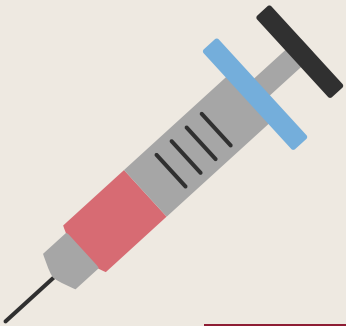
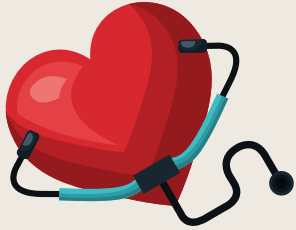
